

An article by Thomas S. Rainer recently caught my attention. Mr. Rainer is President and CEO of Lifeway Christian Resources. The article I noticed was about; "5 realities of churches in North America".

Reality Number Five was what really caught my eye; "Churches growing through conversions are intentionally evangelistic." (My underline) Reality Number three states; "Growing churches are primarily growing through transfer growth".

I have always felt true growth, Kingdom Growth, is only seen through conversions, and Mr. Rainer and his team of researchers of church growth learned that this happens when churches are intentionally evangelistic. In fact they concluded that evangelism doesn't truly happen "unless the church is intentional about it."

He gave an example of hope for any church and pastor who wants to "turn things around evangelically", by citing his own experience of growing his first church from 7 to nearly 70, simply by the Holy Spirit giving opportunities to share the Gospel. He said it started when he led one person to Christ; then others in the congregation followed his leading by example.

My take from all this is: To truly grow God's kingdom through our SBA churches we must obediently fulfill the Great Commission <u>intentionally</u> through <u>Intentional Evangelism</u>.
