Original Search Vision:

- Available to work at least 20-25 hours a week as the Student Ministry Intern.
- Must have a high school diploma or its equivalent, preferably finished at least 1st year of college.
- Personal relationship with Christ.
- Strong team spirit and support for the other members of the staff.

Projects/Skills to grow-in:

- Assist in Student Ministry administration, planning ministry events and gatherings.
- Grow relationships with students, adult leaders, and parents of students and point them to Christ in conversation and action.
- Assist/teach in Sunday Mornings/Nights Life Group, and Wednesday Nights.
